



The Tax Volunteers are **not** certified tax professionals. If your form is complicated (business earning depreciation, stock sales, farm income) or outside the established guidelines, please seek the assistance of a tax professional.

To aid in the tax preparation, please bring all tax documents to your appointment, including last years return.
